THE LAWYER He helped her when no one else would

When Ms Laendra Ramm enlisted the help of entertainment and criminal lawyer Monroe Mann in early 2011, no country or organization wanted to take on the responsibility of dealing with Colin Mak.

The singer approached Mr Mann after a call he gave on networking and he agreed to help her. "I knew Colin was suffering from harassment by cyberstalkers but nobody knew of them. But actually, Laendra showed up that day," Mr Mann told ZDF ten weeks ago.

Ms Mann said they first tried to deal with the "one page rant" by Mak on various social media platforms. "We asked Google to remove some negative posts it tagged as bad," she said. In take down Colin's offending posts about Laendra, but none of them wanted to help us or him."

It took several months of persuasion before they agreed. Ms Mann said he was initially told by US and Singapore police that they could not do anything because Mak and Ms Ramm were not in their jurisdictions, respectively. "We were getting told 'no' back and forth," he said.

"There is no international law that governs such cases, even though cyberstalking is a criminal offence. But it shouldn't matter which city the perpetrator is in because this causes serious harm to people's lives."

In a last-ditch effort to save Ms Ramm from her tormentor, she contacted a Singapore hotel of all Singapore hotels that Mak had broken and sent it to the Singapore police in March 2011. Almost three months after he started to stalk her, she said: "We included fees such as criminal investigation and harassment, and it was clear that Mak had broken them. I knew this was make or break. It was the last roll of the dice."

His efforts paid off when police emailed him in July 2011 to say they had arrested Mak and were investigating the crime.

THE FORENSIC EXPERT He compiled database of 5,000 e-mails, letters

When US data forensic expert A.J. Fardella heard about Ms Laendra Ramm's six years of being stalked by Colin Mak, he felt it was more serious than cyberstalking.

Ms Fardella, who met the US singer in March 2011, told "the how" after a phone interview: "It wasn't even cyberstalking, it was cyberterrorism."

He discussed in case and ZNN has seen seven cases and threats to her personal employees, in her family, to people who she was performing with and portrayed her as a prostitute, a criminal. The living hell she was put through (Fardella could not be reached for comment).

That same month, he contacted the Singapore police investigators, who informed him on the procedures to submit evidence.

He then compiled a massive database of evidence against Mak and sent them to the authorities here.

It contained more than 5,000 e-mails, messages, screenshots, letters and files. He also mapped out his connections in the US Secret Service, which he had worked with before.

Three months after in July 2011, Mak was arrested by the Singapore police.

OVERWHELMING Ms Fardella said he found the case overwhelming.

"Laendra said she, her with the number of hours I spent on this case, I doubt I ever made my return wage."

Although Ms Ramm managed to get justice, victims of foreign cyberstalkers are still very much confused, Ms Fardella said.

Ms Fardella and Ms Ramm recently started The Ramm Initiative, which advocates greater cybercrime enforcement across the world.

"We will meet up regularly — either the files in California or I fly to New York," he said.

Singaporean jailed for stalking US singer online

Victim left with post-traumatic stress disorder after six years of threats

The Ramm Initiative was initially a research project that has turned into a multi-college organization working to enact cyber-stalking legislation and reform international treaties to address cyberstalking.

The Alliance Against Cybercrime is committed to helping bring assistance to victims & investigators and justice to perpetrators, regardless of where in the world they are when they offend.


Also, my latest speech at Contra Costa College

I was invited to speak to the computer science students at Contra Costa College in San Pablo, California on December 6th, 2013. Here is an outline of what my talk entailed.

"Leandra Ramm, activist and author, shares her personal story of an international cyber stalking case that continued for six years. Leandra, a former victim, turned survivor, turned activist, reached out to students at Norwich University, the first of which was Cadet Matthew Miller who formed an organization for her cause entitled "The Ramm Initiative"; a multi-college research project with the mission of creating and amending state, federal, and international laws on cyber stalking. This is to aid in bringing cyber stalkers to justice before undue harm is put upon the stalked. The Ramm Initiative is currently incorporated with students at Norwich University, led by Cadet

Matthew Miller with Cadet Logan Morrison and Paul Matthews as executive officers. Leandra shares her touching story of her battle with legislation, her attempts to cease the stalker's activities, her "at bay"/communication period with the stalker, and her final victory with the stalker's arrest, all presented with a power point presentation. With over 5,000 emails from the stalker, multiple defamatory blogs, social media hate groups, identity theft, and other crimes, Leandra endured one of the worst cyber stalking cases some experts say the world has ever seen. At the end of this riveting speech and presentation, Cadets Matthew Miller will speak on the current status of the Ramm Initiative and invite others to join the cause. With a theatrical background, Leandra brings to life her ordeal, gives inspiration to current victims, educates the audience about the current lack of laws, and invites change to occur through the Ramm Initiative with help from dedicated students at Norwich University."
